Return to CE Community Services Parking Lot at 5pm on Wednesday 8/25.

Meals

Dinner on Tuesday 8/24

Breakfast and Lunch on 8/25 *Campers will be required to assist with meal preparation and cleanup*

Accommodations:

Four eight person tents from LLBean. Waterproof. *Campers will be divided into 4 groups lead by each of the 4 senior captains. They will be required to work together to assemble their tents and take them down the next day.*

Campers will bring: sleeping mat (if desired), sleeping bag, toiletries, bathing suits, towels, sneakers, their own lifejacket if they have one (not required)

One Porta Potty will be provided.

Chaperones will be housed inside the camp buildings, separately from the campers.

Training Plan:

Campers will scrimmage two Varsity teams at a round robin sponsored by Leavitt High School on Tuesday 8/24. They will do fitness training, directed by David Weatherbie on Wednesday morning 8/25 and then do team building activities on and around the lake.
