TREE WARDEN

The Town of Cape Elizabeth has an immediate opening for the position of Tree Warden. The Tree Warden works closely with Town staff, standing boards, citizens and contractors on the care and management of trees located on public ways, forested lands and other public areas owned by the Town. Individuals interested in this position should have a combination of training and/or demonstrated experience in the areas of municipal arboriculture, ornamental or landscape horticulture, and urban forestry practices.

Applicants shall have excellent oral and written communication skills and the ability to perform duties on a flexible schedule. Requirements for this position includes possessing a Maine arborist license. Additionally, candidates shall possess the ISA Tree Risk Assessment Qualification (TRAQ), or obtain such qualification within one year of appointment.

The Town's Tree Warden can expect varying levels of work hours, but averages approximately 8 hours per week. This is a part-time stipend position that reports directly to the Director of Public Works. Applicants shall provide a cover letter and resume on or before Friday, April 1, 2022 to:
