- 3. Identify new issues:
 - Demand for new uses
 - Retention of historic features: battery remains, Goddard Mansion, bleachers, buildings, etc.
 - Arboretum
 - Utility infrastructure
 - Natural features: Garden Pond, arboriculture, scenic vistas, etc.
 - Potential revenue generating facilities (based on the Business Plan)
