A primary objective of the SBAC is to propose a revised referendum by November 2024.

- Monitor and analyze public sentiment and provide recommendations for course corrections as needed.
- Present regular updates to the SBAC.
- The candidate should be able to attend occasional meetings in person, but the majority of work can be conducted remotely.

- Clarity, innovativeness, and feasibility of the proposed communication and outreach strategy.
- Budget and timeline.
- Feedback from client references.
