Two thoughts:

- We could round out the Key Priorities at the bottom of the School Building Needs a bit more, especially for those who are not going to dive into our full presentations. A good overlap could be to list out the priority groups that Harriman has identified for the options, with a descriptor sentence each.



Key priorities identified for improvement include:

- Enhancing safety and security
- Improving site plans for better vehicle and pedestrian movement
- Modernizing classrooms to support contemporary teaching methods
- · Redesigning layouts for effective collaboration

Infrastructure upgrades also need to be addressed a

- · Technology enhancements
- · Improved natural lighting
- Adequate storage solutions
- Efficient HVAC systems
- I think that critical information is tucked in the scrolling pdf "Presentation What are the school needs?". Would it make sense to have an additional tab that talks about education and current priorities in school design? I know we don't want to bog down the site with too much content, but maybe Harriman has a few strong diagrams and descriptors of 21st century school design that could get pulled out as its own content group? To me, this is one of the most important content areas that we need to ask the community to "learn". Everyone can easily understand replacing old roofs and floors, but I would suspect that most voters have not kept up with the evolution of school design over the last few decades...
