Hello,

I think it would be incredibly helpful to publish, in the Cape Courier, the data you presented tonight (differential effects on property taxes across options E, C and B). I also think it would be incredibly helpful if the committee could publish FUTURE spending data on maintenance and repairs, especially if options C or B are brought forward. The upfront tax bill for E is largest but I can only imagine the future spend for C or B would be far larger to repair buildings that are past their useful life. Cape residents need to know this data, otherwise I fear that folks will be debating between \$114M and \$78M without having full context.
