In response to a request from one of your members, I am providing a supplemental analysis of the NESDEC Enrollment Report, this time focused on the data used in its October 10, 2023 Report. The conclusions are essentially the same. The difference in enrollment projections demonstrates how changes in mere projections of births may significantly affect the projections of kindergarten enrollment when those

enrollment projections are (incorrectly) assumed to be directly related to births.
