





Site Plan Showing New MS and Possible Location of Future ES









Site Plan Showing New MS and Possible Location of Future ES



ROUGH ORDER OF MAGNITUDE PROJECT COST: **\$XXXXX**

Concept B includes additions and renovations to PCES & CEMS to address efficiency upgrades, healthy building systems, security, and cafeteria improvements. The scope includes new secure entry vestibules for each school with administrative offices and nurse area located near the bus and parent drop-offs; and a new 2-story addition with a shared kitchen that separates the dining spaces for the MS and ES, and classrooms/offices on the 2nd floor for current missing program space. Limited portions of the existing PCES & CEMS will be reconfigured to accommodate other missing program needs. Minor interior improvements will be made to improve wayfinding through the existing facility. The current cafetorium will be converted to a multipurpose space for performances and team gatherings.


CONCEPT "C" ADDITION/RENOVATION



ROUGH ORDER OF MAGNITUDE PROJECT COST: **\$XXXX**

Concept C includes additions and renovations to PCES & CEMS to address efficiency upgrades, healthy building systems, security, cafeteria improvements, rightsizing spaces, providing gathering/collaboration hubs, and agile/flexible classrooms. The scope includes 2 new separate secure entry vestibules and administrative offices; a new 2-story cafeteria/classroom addition (same scope as noted in Concept B above); and heavy renovation/ addition to house the music programs where the current CEMS administrative offices are currently located. Most of the existing PCES & CEMS will be reconfigured to accommodate desired programmatic needs and minor interior improvements for easier wayfinding. The current cafetorium will be converted to a multipurpose space for performances and team gatherings.



Concept E3 includes minimal addition/ renovation to PCES, demolition of CEMS, and construction of a new middle school on the existing soccer field (field to be relocated on site). PCES scope addresses security and select program needs with a new secure entry vestibule and administrative offices, and a small addition next to the library for STEM programs. Small portions of PCES will be reconfigured to accommodate missing program spaces, and minor interior improvements for wayfinding. The new middle school includes a secure entry vestibule and administrative offices, a HS-sized gym with bleachers for 300 people, a large stage that can be accessed from the gym or cafeteria that can accommodate 100 band members, a library/ STEM space at the heart of the school, and 2 classroom wings.

Concept E3.1 includes major additions and minimal renovations to PCES, demolition of CEMS, and construction of a new middle school on the existing soccer field (field to be relocated on site). PCES scope includes a new secure entry vestibule and administrations, new allied arts spaces, and a new 2-story classroom wing with right-sized classrooms and collaboration/gathering spaces. Small areas of the remaining PCES will be reconfigured for missing program needs and minor improvements for wayfinding. The new middle school includes a secure entry vestibule and administrative offices, a HS-sized gym with bleachers for 300 people, A large stage that can be accessed from the gym or cafeteria that can accommodate 100 band members, a library/STEM space at the heart of the school, and 2 classroom wings.

Existing Elementary / Middle School 2ND FLOOR PLAN & LOWER LEVEL





Existing Elementary / Middle School 2ND FLOOR PLAN & LOWER LEVEL




