I have a feedback comment regarding presentation of the 1-10 scaled items, which I shared in one of our planning

meetings with Bruce and in our meetings last fall.

I have not yet read the results of the survey, so this comment is not at all in response to the data, just in the way it is presented.

For the questions that rank items on a 1-10 scale, I believe grouping all responses between 4 and 7 in a single "neutral" category is not appropriate. There is value in knowing if something is a 4.1 vs a 6.9.

At a minimum we should see a mean score for items rated 1-10. Ideally, items would be broken down into 2 point increments.
