The pain points that stuck out in my mind that are way beyond acceptable at this point are: HVAC noise, the cafeteria, the outdated entrances and spaces with no way for administrators to greet or see what is happening at the entrances (safety!), long walk to the classrooms for the middle schoolers, and the gym floor that may be leaching chemicals because it's overdue to be replaced. Concept E is the only one that addresses all of the maintenance and outdated issues and the only option that will support our schools and our kids as we move forward for the next generations.
