Dear Cape Elizabeth SBAC,

First, thank you for all of the time and dedication you have put into supporting the new school project.

I want to let you know that I fully support Option E, a new middle school, as it is the only logical choice of the three options left. Option E (new middle school), is the least disruptive to students, meets the most educational and programmatic needs, sets Cape Elizabeth up for long term financially sustainable investment in school infrastructure, and is only \$33/month more (for the average home in Cape Elizabeth valued at \$700k) than the cheapest option B. The minimal extra investment from taxpayers for so much more value is a no-brainer!

Let me also be crystal clear - I will only vote for an option that includes a new building. My original preference was Option F, as 2 new schools would have been only slightly more cost, but a more efficient use of taxpayers money. Option E is a compromise.

Thank you again for your time and dedication to education in our community. It's time to fully support our teachers, staff, and learners. Let us be the voice of reason and support for why people move to Cape Elizabeth.
