First of all, thank you for the time, effort, and thoughtfulness you have dedicated to this process. I appreciate your service to our community.

I am writing to express my support for Option E. After reviewing the materials and attending several of the meetings, it has become very clear that Option E is a more responsible choice. Not only is it more fiscally responsible, it will be less disruptive for students and staff. Options B and C are not a good use of our tax dollars and would, according to the consultants, require more repairs and renovations, or replacement within the 20 years of the bond funding Option B or C. I am concerned the town would be setting itself up for requiring all three school buildings be replaced around the same time; that feels like an insurmountable ask of the future residents of Cape Elizabeth.
