New Business

1. **Consideration to discuss the Federal Education Jobs Bill.** The Superintendent reviewed ARRA Funds distribution with the Board. He then reviewed the Federal Education Jobs Bill funding. He and Pauline Aportria answered questions. Dominic DePatsy spoke about the one and a half paraprofessionals (ed techs). Also discussed on Mort Soule’s Latin II & III proposal. Decision was made not to include in the FEJB funding.

-Ms. Ray made a motion to accept the FJB Funding proposal for FY11 and FY12 (\$583,260) subject to changing circumstances, with adjustments to another area requiring approval by the Board. Ms. Winker seconded. (Approved 6-0)

2. **Consideration to discuss the collection and reporting of students’ social security numbers.** The Superintendent reviewed the new law requiring that schools request student social security numbers with the Board.

-Ms. Ray made a motion to remove all current student social security numbers from district systems and proposed including a note from the School Board to discourage parents from providing student social security numbers as the state is requesting. Ms. Winker seconded. (Approved 6-0)
