
The Cape Elizabeth School Department authorizes the Cape Elizabeth Baseball Boosters, under the direction of Ken Pierce, to sell banners at Holman Field. These banners would be similar in nature to the banners that have been in place for some number of years at Lions Field. Based on Planning Board agreement, Charter 21-4-4, these banners can be placed on town and school managed fields but the final agreement for school-managed fields is the decision of the Cape Elizabeth School Board.

This agreement will allow the Baseball Boosters to sell the signs and to allow printing on them. The Cape Elizabeth School Board limits the content of these signs to meet federal and state requirements regarding school use. The Cape Elizabeth School Board also limits the advertising on the signs to avoid religious, food, smoking, alcoholic, and/or sexual products. All printed messages on the signs must first be approved by the Superintendent of Schools or his designee.


