With an increase in our staple ingredients and other supplies I am asking that the school lunch price increase as follows:

- Students from \$2.85 to \$3.00
- Non-subsidized adult from \$4.00 to \$4.25

Correspondence from Walter Beesley, State Education Specialist says ~

- The state's maximum per meal charge for students in SY12 is \$3.00 - *A waiver must be requested from the state for districts intending to charge the maximum price of \$3.00 or more.*
- C.E.'s *per meal cost* for adults is \$3.95, so we need to charge at least \$4.15.

We are a system that depends on the full cost of meals, due to the small free and reduced lunch population.

In the 2008-09 school year -

Student Lunch rates were increased from \$2.50 to \$2.85

Adult Lunch rates went from \$3.00 to \$3.50

In the 2009-10 school year -

Lunch rates for adults were increased to \$4.00.
