# Springtime in Québec City!

Department of Modern Languages Trip Proposal February 14, 2012

We've decided to offer the French students the opportunity to take a trip to Québec City this Spring! Here are some highlights:

Students will have the opportunity to practice their French as much as they like! Accomplishing everyday tasks in the target language is a great confidence builder for students of French. Tours will be in English, however, so students in less advanced levels will not be at a disadvantage.

Due to the relatively short duration of the trip, students will only miss one complete school day, Friday the 27th of April. We'll return Sunday night.

Due to our proximity to Québec and the short duration of the trip, our trip to Québec will not be as expensive as some other trips available to students. The cost for 24 students is \$450-475 per student.

Students will keep to a tight schedule rich in activities that emphasize the artisanal nature of Québecois cultural heritage and Québec's natural and man-made beauty.

There is very little down time built into the schedule.

Students may choose to purchase trip insurance from the tour provider for \$38. This is medical, cancellation, and lost baggage coverage.

And lastly, it must be said, we will be bringing a Breathalyzer with us on the trip. Though some students may be of legal drinking age in Canada at the time of the trip, all students must agree to operate under school policy for the duration of the trip. No student may engage in drinking of alcohol at any time during school activities.
