Day 1: Fly overnight to Greece

Day 2: Athens

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Athens and discover the ancient city named for Athena, goddess of war and wisdom. During your stay you'll visit the Acropolis to view the Parthenon, perhaps the world's greatest architectural feat. See the Temple of Athena Nike, which once housed a gold statue of the goddess, her wings clipped to prevent her from deserting the city. Snap a picture of the Presidential Guard in traditional costume, then pass the stadium that hosted the first modern Olympics in 1896. You'll also have the chance to see the Temple of Olympian Zeus, built in 515 B.C. to honor the most powerful of all Greek gods.
- Take a walking tour of Athens: Plaka district; Temple of Olympian Zeus

Day 3: Athens

- Take an expertly guided tour of Athens: Olympic Stadium
- Visit the Acropolis: Parthenon; Temple of Athena Nike
- Visit the Acropolis Museum

Day 4: Athens

 Full day to see more of Athens or
Enjoy a Saronic Islands cruise: Poros; Hydra; Aegina

Day 5: Delphi | Patras

- Travel to Delphi, where you will visit the archaeological site and museum centered around the Oracle of Delphi, one of the most important landmarks of antiquity. The philosopher Socrates claimed to consult with the Oracle here and ancient military leaders left offerings in the hopes of earning luck in battle. Ponder the mysteries that lie in your future as you climb the ruins of the Temple of Apollo. According to legend, this is where the gods chose to communicate with mortals. See a variety of artifacts dating back to 550 B.C. at the Delphi Museum, and learn more about the mythical past of Greece.
- Take an expertly guided tour of Delphi: Temple of Apollo
- Visit the Delphi Museum
- Continue on to Patras

Day 6: Olympia | Argolida

- Travel to Olympia and stand on the site of the first Olympic Games. Ancient myth attributes Hercules with founding the Ancient Olympic Games nearly 2,800 years ago. Hercules is also credited with establishing the tradition of holding competitions every four years between Greek city-states. See where the original Olympic athletes displayed physical strength and endurance as a way to honor and entertain the gods of Mount Olympus-especially Zeus. Today, the Olympic flame remains lit by a reflection of sunlight at the restored stadium in Olympia. Be sure to peruse the Olympia Archaeological Museum, which houses bronze, terracotta and sculptured artifacts related to the Olympic Games and their history.
- Take an expertly guided tour of Olympia
- Visit the Olympia Museum
- Continue on to Argolida

Day 7: Epidaurus | Mycenae | Athens

- Travel to Epidaurus
- Take an expertly guided tour of Epidaurus
- Continue on to Mycenae
- Take an expertly guided tour of Mycenae
- Make a photo stop at the Corinth Canal
- Continue on to Athens

Day 8: Cape Sounion | Athens

- Travel to Cape Sounion
- Take an expertly guided tour of Cape Sounion
- Visit the Temple of Poseidon
- Enjoy a free evening or
- Attend a Greek Evening
