 - o April 5, 2017
 - Participation Rate = 98%
- Released items



- Grades 5, 8, and third year of high school (typically grade 11)
- Paper/pencil
- Aligned to MLR (not NGSS)
- Test Sessions
 - Grade 5: Three sessions (30 minutes each)
 - Grade 8: Three sessions (35 minutes each)
 - Grade 11: Two sessions (50 minutes each)
- Participation Rates = 96%
