Kurt,

We met about a year ago and had a nice walk/tour of the Crescent Beach facilities and long-range plans for improvements.

One of my responsibilities as Cape Town Planner is to staff the Conservation Committee. They are charged with stewardship of the town greenbelt network and are always looking at trail extensions and improvements. At last month's meeting, they noted that existing trails at Crescent Beach that connect to Two Lights Rd are becoming overgrown. They would like to keep the trail open and are interested in any plans by the state to do some vegetation management. Alternately, they would like permission for the town to perform that work. The work might be done by CC members, or by our seasonal trails maintenance employee.
