Maureen, I understand that our requirement for the road width of 22 feet in this project would result in several oak trees being removed. While I don't wish to see the trees destroyed I look at the road width requirement as an important element in our ability to deliver emergency services. Narrow roads can compromise our ability to deliver emergency services in a timely fashion.

If the board wishes to allow the narrower road width to preserve these trees I would be willing to support that desire if these two conditions are included in the approval. First any residences built off this road would be required to have residential sprinklers installed and second if multiple dwellings are to be built the road would have to be widened to 22 feet.
