
This letter is provided in support of the Town of Cape Elizabeth's grant application for the *Trout Brook Watershed Restoration Project, Phase II*.

The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, located at 29 Ocean House Road in Cape Elizabeth, is committed to working with the Town of Cape Elizabeth and the Cumberland County Soil & Water Conservation District (CCSWCD) to protect and restore the water quality of Trout Brook. - Grant Cape Elizabeth and CCSWCD access to the property for the proposed work to:
 - Collect the Church building's roof runoff,
 - Rehabilitate or retrofit the existing detention basin on the property, and

- Provide a total of sixteen (16) hours of in-kind services for planting the proposed vegetated underdrained soil filter.
