Thank you for your quick response.

We moved to Cape Elizabeth on Stonybrook Road in 1966 and I attended Cottage Farms Elementary School, 6th grade at the Town Hall, Middle School and graduated from CEHS in 1975. I moved from Cape Elizabeth after attending college, but my parents, Sophie and Bill Kourakos resided in my childhood home until November 1999 when they moved to 3 Maple Lane, Cape Elizabeth. My father passed away in 2006 and my mother moved to Piper Shores in 2009. My husband and I have not resided in Cape Elizabeth.

Although I moved from Cape after college, I have continued to visit several times each year since then. I do still have family in Cape Elizabeth. My brother has a home in Cape Elizabeth, 15 Two Lights Terrace. We have spent nearly every Thanksgiving and Christmas since the early 80's in Cape and we visit numerous times each year spending time at Kettle Cove, Crescent Beach, Two Lights State Park and Fort Williams.
