His research on the matter indicates that it is likely not Constitutional to ban signature gathering on public property (items part of meeting packet).
- ii. Reviewed note from Sara Hirshon agreeing that the Library cannot ban such action on public property. Kathleen Kent stated that the State of Maine website suggests

using libraries as a place to gather signatures. All committee members present agree signature gathering should be allowed. Kyle will followup with Matt.
