TMLF Generator Proposal

I shared with Matt the same update I did with this group from my meeting with George on the TMLF Executive Committee's recommendation to the full TMLF to put the generator proposal on hold while they explored the solar option further and once again consulted with Town Council on their plans for a town wide system. On May 21, Matt wrote to George thanking him for the TMLF's consideration but notified him that the Town was withdrawing its proposal and would put a generator for the library in the CIP cycle.
