

NOTICE OF AMOUNTS ADOPTED AT TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
FOR VOTERS AT SCHOOL BUDGET
VALIDATION REFERENDUM

Pursuant to 20-A M.R.S.A. §§ 1486(2) and 2307 this Notice is to be displayed at all polling places for the school budget validation referendum to be held on Tuesday, June 11, 2024, to assist the voters in voting on whether to ratify the school budget approved at the Monday, May 13, 2024 Town Council Meeting.

Note: *The amount adopted by the Town Council is the amount submitted to the voters at referendum. If the council has changed the total budget recommended by the school committee, and that change is approved at referendum, the school committee shall adjust the individual cost center lines as provided by 20-A M.R.S.A. §2307.*



Summary of Total Authorized School Budget Expenditures




