Item # 121-2006 Acting Town Clerk

The Town Manager has appointed Jacqueline N. Coy as Acting Town Clerk subject to the approval of the Town Council. Deborah Cabana, will begin serving as Town Manager of Gray, Maine on July 24th and completed her service as Cape Elizabeth Town Clerk on July 7, 2006. The search process for a new Town Clerk is underway. Jacqueline Coy and Matthew Sturgis are assisting the Town Manager with the interview process. Item # 122-2006 Spurwink Church Study Committee Report

It is proposed to thank the Spurwink Church Study Committee for their report and to refer the report to a future workshop meeting.

Item # 123-2006 Wastewater Submeters

The Portland Water District wishes to retrofit submeters so that they are compatible with new water meters. Submeters measure the water usage that is going through the main meter, but not into the sewer system. Submeters are currently installed at the expense of the property owner. The Portland Water District has indicated that in order to recover the capital and operating costs of the retrofit, the needed estimated monthly surcharge to submeter accounts would be approximately \$2.00 per month. The District has indicated that if the Town does not authorize the retrofit, the submeters will not be read by the District and the customer will not receive a wastewater bill adjustment for the water flowing through the submeter. It is recommended that the Town Council approve the surcharge to be effective when the Portland Water District implements the program.

Item # 124-2006 Grant Acceptance

It is proposed to accept a \$5,670 US Fish and Wildlife Service 2006 Rural Fire Assistance grant with a required local match of \$630.00. The funds are to be used for the purchase of one mobile radio and six portable radios. The local match funds are in the FY 2007 budget.

Item # 125-2006 Acceptance of Deeds and Easements
