

It is a real pleasure to have the two communities working together with a common goal. It is a fun group but a working team. They are all wonderful.

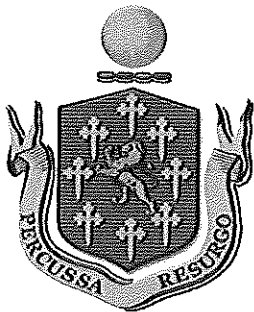
