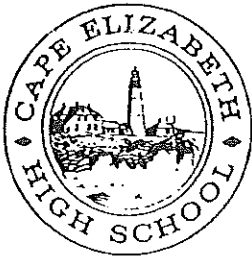

Dear Mr. Malley,

I recently received an e-mail from you to Nick Dambrie, last year's race officer of the Portland Yacht Club. Nick has retired and I have been appointed race officer for the 2011 season so would be the one to ask for your assistance in use of Fort Williams for our Monhegan Island Race. We have scheduled our race so as not to conflict with the Beach to Beacon and will start Friday August 12th and finish Sunday August 14th.

I would ask permission to park our 35' RV along the walkway and fence on the field just south of Portland Head Light from approximately noon August 12th until the last boat finishes hopefully prior to sunrise Sunday the 14th. We would ask permission to attach a 10 foot wooden 2x4 with our radio antennae and orange finish line flag attached to one of the fence posts using rope and nylon ties, running the antennae wire over the paved path between the fence and the RV. We would also ask permission to park a maximum of two cars beside the RV for our finishing crews. Last year one of the Park personnel provided us a key for evening access to the front gate in case we had a medical emergency which thankfully we did not use. If this is still possible, it would relieve some anxiety by older members of the crew.

I look forward to working with you. I spent most of Saturday last year at the Park in and around the Finish RV and had a ball chatting with Park patrons who came over to us. Others on the finish crew had similar experiences as well. Please contact me with your concerns and need for me to complete paperwork, etc.
