- In the event contract signatory changes, this Agreement shall remain valid until the agreed upon expiration/renewal date
- Exclusive streaming video rights for the program described herein only

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties and supersedes any and all prior communications, understandings agreements, whether oral or written. No modification or claimed waiver of any provision shall be valid except by written amendments by the parties herein.
