## (a) Section 125 Plan

The Town of Cape Elizabeth offers a Section 125 Plan reimbursement account through <u>Horace Mann Insurance</u>. Maine School Management Association. The Town may choose another provider at its option. Medical expense reimbursement accounts are limited to the <u>maximum permitted under federal law</u>. \$3000 per year. Dependent care reimbursement accounts are limited to \$5,000 per calendar year per family <u>but may be lower if the maximum allowed by federal law is less than \$5,000</u>. The enrollment period for this program occurs once annually or on the initial hire date. (Rev. Eff. 01/10/11)
