

Town of Cape Elizabeth
Policies for Naming of Facilities
As of April 14, 2014

Introduction

The Town of Cape Elizabeth through its ownership of land and buildings has opportunities to honor individuals and groups with the naming of facilities or portions thereof. In the past, the town council or the board of selectmen has approved the following designations:

- Lion's Field (Also provided for in the deed)
- Hannaford Field (Agreement signed effective through December 31, 2031)
- Capano Field- In honor of longtime teacher and coach Edmund Capano
- Holman Field- In honor of longtime teacher and coach Durward Holman
- Rey Moulton Field- in honor of school benefactor Rey Moulton
- Keith Weatherbie Track- in honor of longtime teacher, coach and athletic director Keith Weatherbie
- Donald L. Richards Community Pool and Fitness Center - in honor of longtime teacher and coach Donald Richards
- Plaisted Park- In honor of Harris M. Plaisted, a founder of Cape Elizabeth Little League
- Tarbox Triangle (also provided for in the deed) In honor of Patricia Tarbox
- Winnick Woods- In honor of Louis and Ruth Winnick
- Dyer Woods
- Loveitt Heirs Parcel
- Thomas Memorial Library (also provided for in gift acceptance)
- William H. Jordan Conference Room- in honor of longtime elected official and fire chief William H. Jordan
- David W. Pickering Conference Room- in honor of longtime police chief David W. Pickering

Policy for School Buildings and Grounds

In 2007, the Cape Elizabeth School Board and the Cape Elizabeth Town Council approved the following policy:

FF - Naming of School Facilities

It is appropriate from time to time to consider naming a school facility or some portion thereof to recognize an individual, group or other entity who has made significant contributions of time, talent or treasure to the Cape Elizabeth School Department.

The designation of any room or facility inside a school building shall be reviewed and approved by the School Board.

The designation of any school facility outside a school building, such as an athletic field, or an ancillary building or naming of the school itself, shall be reviewed and approved by the School Board and the Town Council. The Town Council will consider any such proposal only after an affirmative vote of the School Board.
